Blood sugar test kits	Lice treatments	Vision services like exams, eyeglasses, frames and contact lenses
Braces and supports	Medical monitoring and testing	Vitamins
Breast pumps and lactation supplies	Menstrual care (tampons, pads, etc.)	Walkers, wheelchairs and canes
Catheters	Motion sickness medicines	Weight loss drugs and programs
Chiropractor	Nasal sprays or drops	
Cold and flu medicines	Ointments for cuts, burns or rashes
