Adult day care center	Nanny
After school program	Nursery school
Babysitting while you work (in your home or someone else's)	Payment processing fees
Babysitting by your relative who is not considered a dependent on your tax return (while you work)	Payroll taxes related to eligible care
Before- or after-school program	Preschool
Child care	Registration fees (required for eligible care, after actual services are received)
Custodial eldercare while you work	Sick childcare
Dependent or eldercare (while you work, to enable you to work or look for work)	Senior day care
Extended care (supervised program before or after regular school hours) for dependents under age 13	Summer day camp
Eldercare (in your home or someone else's)	Total payment (transferred from previous administrator)
Housekeeper who cares for child (only portion of payment attributable to childcare while you work)	Transportation to and from eligible care (provided by your care provider)

Examples of ineligible expenses:

- Activity fees
- Custodial eldercare
- Dance lessons
- Day nursing care
- Educational, learning or study skills services
- Field trips
- Household services (housekeeping, maid, cook, etc.)
- Kindergarten tuition
- Language classes
- Late payment fees
- Meals, food or snacks
- Medical care
- Miscellaneous fees (diapers, clothing, etc.)
- Nursing home care
- Piano lessons
- Private school tuition (for kindergarten and up)
- Registration fees (required for eligible care, prior to actual services being received)
- School tuition
- Sleep-away camp
- Transportation to and from eligible care (not provided by your care provider)
- Tutoring
